**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

**WHEREAS**, on August 10, 2022, the Trinity County Director of Emergency Services = declared a local emergency due to the 2022 Lightning Fires – Six River Lightning Complex.; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 16, 2022, the Board of Supervisors confirmed the existence of the local emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, Trinity County’s Emergency Operations Plan states “the Board will review the need for continuing the local emergency at its regularly scheduled meetings at least every 60 days; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2022-146, 2022-192, and 2023-013 and confirming the continuance of the local emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions described in the original proclamation, attached as Exhibit A, continue;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Trinity confirms the continuance of the local emergency due to the 2022 Lightning Fires – Six River Complex.
