A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF TRINITY CONFIRMING THE CONTINUANCE OF A LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY DUE TO 2021 FIRE HAZARDS

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2021, the Trinity County Health Officer declared a local health emergency due to the hazardous products of combustion, water quality, and threats in Trinity County from wildfire; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2021, the Board of Supervisors confirmed the existence of the local health emergency; and

WHEREAS, Section 101080 of the California Health and Safety Code requires the Board to review and reaffirm the need for continuing a local emergency every thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2021-090, 2021-107, 2021-117, 2021-126, 2021-135, 2022-010, 2022-019, 2022-032, 2022-043, 2022-054, 2022-071, 2022-080, 2022-093, 2022-124, 2022-132, 2022-167, 2022-174, 2022-179, 2023-001 and 2023-014 and confirming the continuance of the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the wildfires causing hazardous material concerns in Trinity County continue to burn and the conditions described in the original proclamation, attached as Exhibit A, continue; and

WHEREAS, the original proclamation is amended to add River Complex between "McFarland Fire" and "other fires" in the fourth whereas statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Trinity confirms the continuance of a local health emergency due to the hazardous material caused by fires currently burning.
