A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF TRINITY
CONFIRMING THE CONTINUANCE OF A LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY
DUE HAZARDOUS UNHEALTHY DEBRIS AND AIR QUALITY CONCERNS CAUSED BY
THE 2022 LIGHTNING FIRES- SIX RIVERS COMPLEX

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2022, the Trinity County Health Officer declared a local health emergency due to hazardous unhealthy debris and air quality concerns caused by the 2022 Lightning Fires- Six Rivers Complex.; and

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2022, the Board of Supervisors confirmed the existence of the local health emergency; and

WHEREAS, Section 101080 of the California Health and Safety Code requires the Board to review and reaffirm the need for continuing a local emergency every thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, the wildfires causing hazardous material concerns in Trinity County continue to burn and the conditions described in the original proclamation, attached as Exhibit A, continue; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No 2022-167, 2022-176, 2022-181, 2023-003, and 2023-016 and confirming the continuance of the local emergency; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Trinity confirms the continuance of a local health emergency due to hazardous unhealthy debris and air quality concerns caused by the 2022 Lightning Fires- Six Rivers Complex.
