

RE: Appeal of Planning Commission Action – P-22-19: Lot Line Adjustment

Attached you will find the form and fees needed to appeal the Planning Commission determination and related items regarding the above project made on November 17, 2022. It was our goal to address these matters with Planning Department staff and reach agreement regarding how to proceed without having to file this appeal. Unfortunately, the following constraints prevented this from happening:

- 1. The Planning Commission meeting was rescheduled from November 10 to November 17, which pushed the time period for action into the Thanksgiving holiday where the Planning Department was closed on Thursday and Friday, November 24 and 25.
- 2. The interim Deputy Planning Director was on vacation Monday-Wednesday, November 21-23.
- 3. Multiple staff members were out due to illness the week of November 28 December 2.
- 4. The first opportunity to meet with appropriate Planning staff was today, Monday December 5 day ten of the ten-day period to file appeal.

Given the above factors, agreement on how to proceed did not happen today, although it likely will within the next day or two. To this end, this letter serves as my official request to have the Clerk of the Board hold our application for appeal until close-of-business on Thursday, December 8. By that time, I will contact the clerk and either request the application and fee for appeal to be returned to me without action, or to be processed for action.

Thank you for understanding the difficult position my wife and I are in. It was our intent to have the matters that would determine if appeal was necessary resolved well in advance of today, but could not do so through no fault of our own. We are submitting this today only because it is the last day to do so by ordinance, despite it likely being unnecessary.
