 - Find the adoption and implementation of this ordinance to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), common-sense exemption, which applies to projects where the activity in question will not result in a significant effect on the environment;
 - 2. Direct whether a Cannabis storefront retail establishment should be allowed in each established opt out area;
 - 3. Direct whether a Cannabis storefront retail establishment should require a Director's Use Permit (DUP) in any zone;
 - 4. Introduce and waive the reading of an ordinance establishing Trinity County Code Section 17.43H regarding Cannabis Storefront Retail and amending Trinity County Code Sections 17.41 regarding Marijuana (Cannabis) Dispensaries and 17.42 regarding Medical Cannabis Cultivation Regulations;
 - 5. Direct staff to develop and encourage retailers to implement a "local-first" strategy including criteria to promote locally grown cannabis and locally produced cannabis products to the greatest extent feasible; and
 - 6. Direct staff to file a CEQA Notice of Exemption within five days of this action.
